Bored? Feel like doing something with your life? Want to make new friends? Then get a taste of Explorer Scouting. It's the most dynamic group you will find.

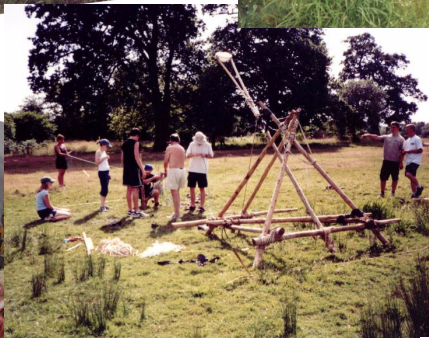
Explorers are young people, aged 14 - 18, a team who put fun and friendship FIRST.

Expeditions and weekends away, taking part in outdoor activities, or working on special projects are all part of the programme, in fact if its legal you could do it!.

Explorers measure their achievements by a series of Awards which culminate in The Queen's Scout Award and The Duke of Edinburgh's Gold Award. All are recognised by Employers as proof that you can make the grade.
